



Adventures Around the World

Denali

Wild and primitive Denali National Park encompasses about 9500 square miles (approximately 6 million acres). Though it derives its name from the native name for the tallest mountain in North America, Mount McKinley at 20, 320 feet (Denali – "the high one"), it also includes Mt. Foraker at 17,400 feet and Mt. Silverthrone at 13,220 feet.

Many glaciers originate on the slope of the Alaska range, Muldrow being one of the largest, reaches close to the park road and is visible from several locations. The Park is located about 240 miles north of Anchorage and 120 mile south of Fairbanks on the George Parks Highway. Denali tours can be divided into two regions. The North Region, near the town of Healy is where the park entrance is and has rafting, dog sledding tours, flightseeing tours, and wilderness adventures. The South Region, near Talkeetna offers spectacular views of Denali and has flightseeing tours, river tours and fishing adventures.

The following day trips offer a unique experience in Denali away from the crowds while providing you with superior customer service and customized itineraries.

Denali (South Region near Talkeetna)

Flightseeing Adventures

1. McKinley Flightseeing

This magnificent flight takes you within six miles of Mt. McKinley's summit. As your flight departs Talkeetna, you begin to see how the last ice age has shaped the land. Moments later, you enter a world of rugged high mountain peaks and wide glacier filled valleys.

2. McKinley Flightseeing Part 2

Extend your McKinley Experience Tour and fly to the remote western end of Denali national Park. Explore the south side of Mt. McKinley (20,320 feet), Mt. Foraker (17,400 feet) and Mt. Hunter (14,573 feet). Fly over the winding Kahiltna Glacier, the longest glacier in Denali National Park (45 miles long and 3 miles wide).

3. Denali Grand

Jetboat Adventures

1. Wilderness Jet Boat Adventure

2. Three Rivers Tour

Rafting Adventures

1. Upper Nenana Wilderness Float

The Nenana River flows northward through the heart of the Alaska Range and forms the eastern border of Denali National Park. Taking place on the upper, more quiet section of the river, this 11 mile scenic float features Class II and III whitewater, and is suitable for ages 5 and up.
